
## **HELLO SPRING!**

Since the 2021 edition of the National Planning Policy Framework (NPPF) English councils and neighbourhoods are strongly encouraged to write Design Codes to de-risk development by setting clearer 'quality asks.'

At Create Streets we believe they have huge potential to create more beautiful, popular and sustainable places bar by giving greater clarity upfront on design, and by 'engaging wide and deep' to discover what is locally popular. 
